

Visitation Guidelines for Hamilton Medical Center as of 2/17/22

- General Visitation Hours: 7:00AM 7:30PM daily
- Non-COVID patients may have 2 visitors per patient room permitted at a time from 7:00AM 7:30PM.
- 1 support person may stay overnight in the patient room from 7:30PM 7:00AM.
- **COVID patients** may have only one designated visitor for every 24-hour period (cannot switch out during the day or night) until the patient is no longer under isolation precautions. See COVID patient visitor information for more details.

Expectations for All Visitors

- Visitors who are known to be sick, or have a temperature of 100.4 or higher at screening will not be permitted to enter the hospital, even if they are the designated visitor for a patient who has COVID. This is without exception.
- No visitors under the age of 12 except in special, approved circumstances. Children under 18 must be under direct supervision of an adult guest at all times.
- On entrance, all visitors will have a temperature check and asked pertinent screening questions.
- Masks or face coverings must be worn appropriately at all times, covering the nose and mouth. This is without exception and will be strictly enforced.
- If visitors do not comply with visitation requirements, they will be escorted out and not permitted reentry for visitation.
- Patients with disabilities, as defined by ADA, are permitted a support person at all times.
